

BARN & PIVOT DOORS



Two Doors One Strategy

Barivot (Bah•riv•it) is the name of the family of doors at DIRTT. Both the Pivot and Barn Door types have the same thickness and same internal components, providing consistent aesthetics, better asset management, and in the future they can be more efficiently serviced.

The stiles on glass doors eliminate lock patches and glass penetration from hardware and locking systems, lowering the chance of damage. Should the glass see damage later on, it is easy to replace the glass locally. The new thicker door also gives further sturdiness to the Barn Door format. The Barivot Barn Door continues with similar dimensions as before, only the top and bottom of the frame are slightly wider and thicker to provide a consistent look.

The universal Barivot track system on the Barn Door integrates with the standard top extrusions, drywall conditions, DIRTT's support extrusion (Antler) and clearstory conditions.

Pivot Doors are now adjustable (with optional bottom skirt) for any dramatic fluctuations in the level of the base building floor. To ensure best possible fit, Pivot Doors are ordered after the wall frames are installed. This allows the most accurate measurements. The doors are then quick-shipped to site for fast installation with minimal adjustments.

Finishes are available in: powder-coat, anodized, glass, veneer and chroma-coat

Barivot Details

- Pull Roller-catch on Barn door is quiet and easily adjusted
- Barn door available in Slim or Phat styles (Slim doors are non-locking)
- Glass Pivot doors available in Phat styles.
- Standard widths: 40" for both (up to 42" for barn doors)
- Available in double door configuration
- Pivot Door has height adjustment of 1/8" down and 5/8" up
- Superior acoustics for each type
- Pivot and Barn doors are separate solutions not intended to interchange
